

## IA Meetings

IA meetings are held eight times per year on the last Tuesday of the month except for June, July, August and December.

The IA meeting schedule coincides with the academic year starting in September and concluding in May.

IA meetings are interactive forums for identifying services available in the community and sharing information on current or upcoming initiatives.

Attendees are given the opportunity to present their organization highlights, ask or answer questions and engage in discussion on partnership opportunities.

Conversations and comments must be respectful and constructive.

Agency summaries should be brief and to-the point. Longer presentations can be arranged with the meeting coordinator in advance of the meeting.

Attendees are encouraged to share any print materials for community distribution including business cards, event posters, program calendars, newsletters, etc.

Meetings are typically 1-2 hours duration depending on the number of agencies attending and the amount of information being shared.

Meetings may or may not be recorded; notes are the attendee's responsibility.

## IA Engagement

Attendance at meetings is voluntary.

Participants determine their own level of engagement. Participants may contribute to discussion or may act as passive observers.

Participants may contact presenters or other participants after meetings to request further information or establish connections.

IA members are advised to provide professional, rather than personal, contact information.

New members will receive an email welcoming them to the IA Group. They will then be able to connect with other members or send out emails to the entire group.
