Cyber Security and Phishing Scams!

Phishing is "a fraudulent attempt to obtain sensitive information such as usernames, passwords, account or other identifying numbers under the guise of trustworthy entities via email or phone communications."

A recent email phishing scam goes by the subject heading "OneDrive is about to be deleted". At first glance for library users this may appear to be about OverDrive. It is not! **Do NOT click to open this email!**
