Reading Points

Ages 3-5: One point for every 15 minutes read.

Ages 6-8: One point for every 30 minutes read.

Ages 9-12: One point for every hour read.

Record the blocks of time spent reading each day.

Complete the fun activities at the bottom of the page to earn bonus points!

Bring the booklet to the club meeting where the points will be tallied & prizes will be awarded.

Community Reading

Choose to read with seniors at one of our participating locations (one-on-one sessions, sign up required first), OR read to the animals at Cause for Critters (drop in during public hours).

Community reading earns double reading points!



Prizes

Everyone will get a chance to win a prize!

Anyone who joins SRC is awarded a free Family pass to Drayton Valley Museum. (valid for 1 year).

The prize bins start at 5 points, and then go to 20, 30, 40, 50+ points.

Every week the points will be added up and those who hit the appropriate points will get to choose a prize.

At the end of Summer Reading Club, we will be giving out grand prizes for those who have the most points! We will have the 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place for each age group as well as distinction awards.
