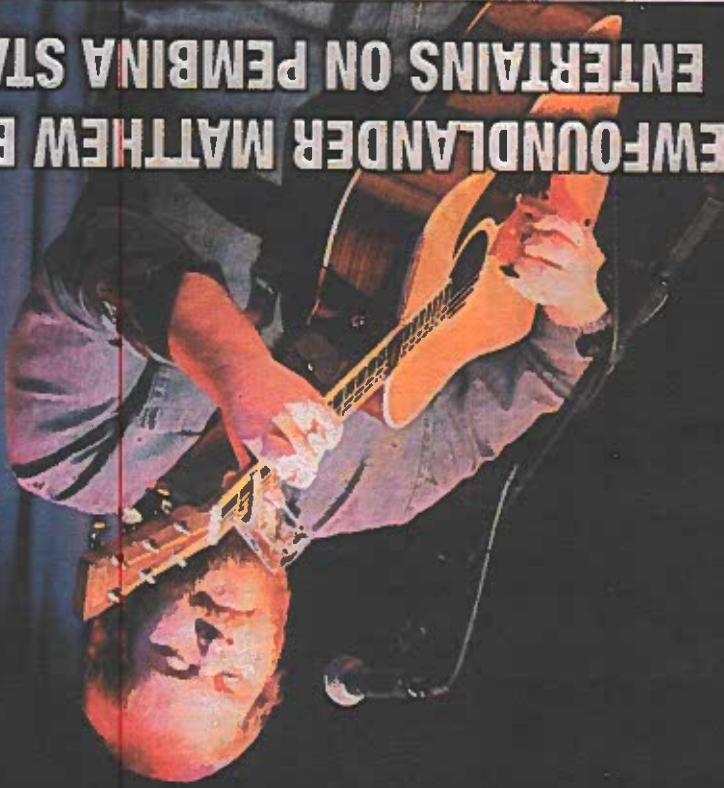

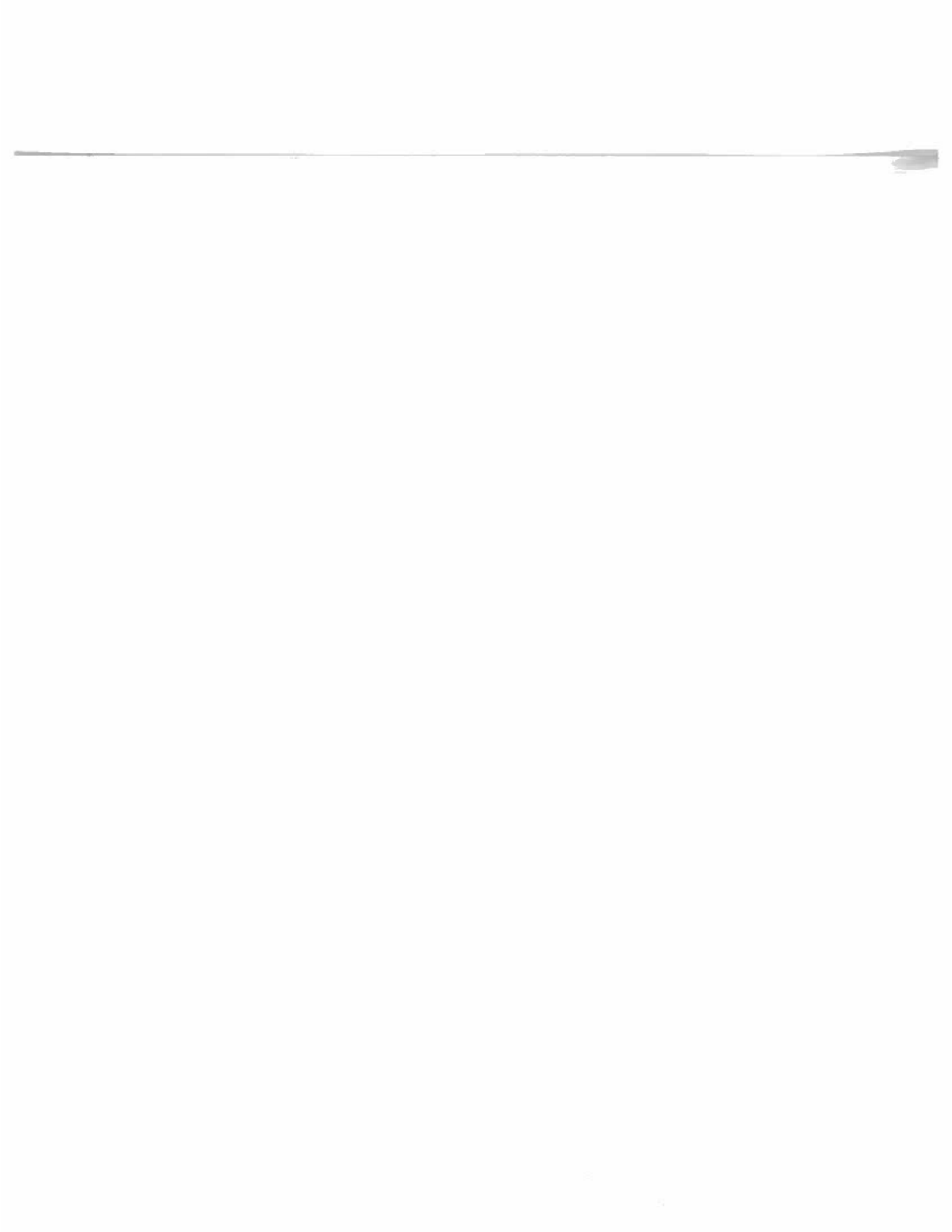

Drayton Valley Town Council amends bylaws

With Councilor Corey Peebles at the helm, Drayton Valley Town Council was busy January 16 with three public hearings and a slew of other business.

A short public hearing took place at the top of the agenda regarding Bylaw No. 2018/16/D - Land Use Amending (Cannabis Production/Distribution) Bylaw. Its purpose was to receive comments, concerns and questions from the public regarding proposed changes to the Town's Land Use Bylaw 2007/24/D for:

- The inclusion of Cannabis Production/Distribution bylaw, requesting comments from the public, and
- Provision of required setbacks for Cannabis Production/Distribution Facilities.

By way of a background, this bylaw received First Reading at the November 27, 2018 regular council meeting. 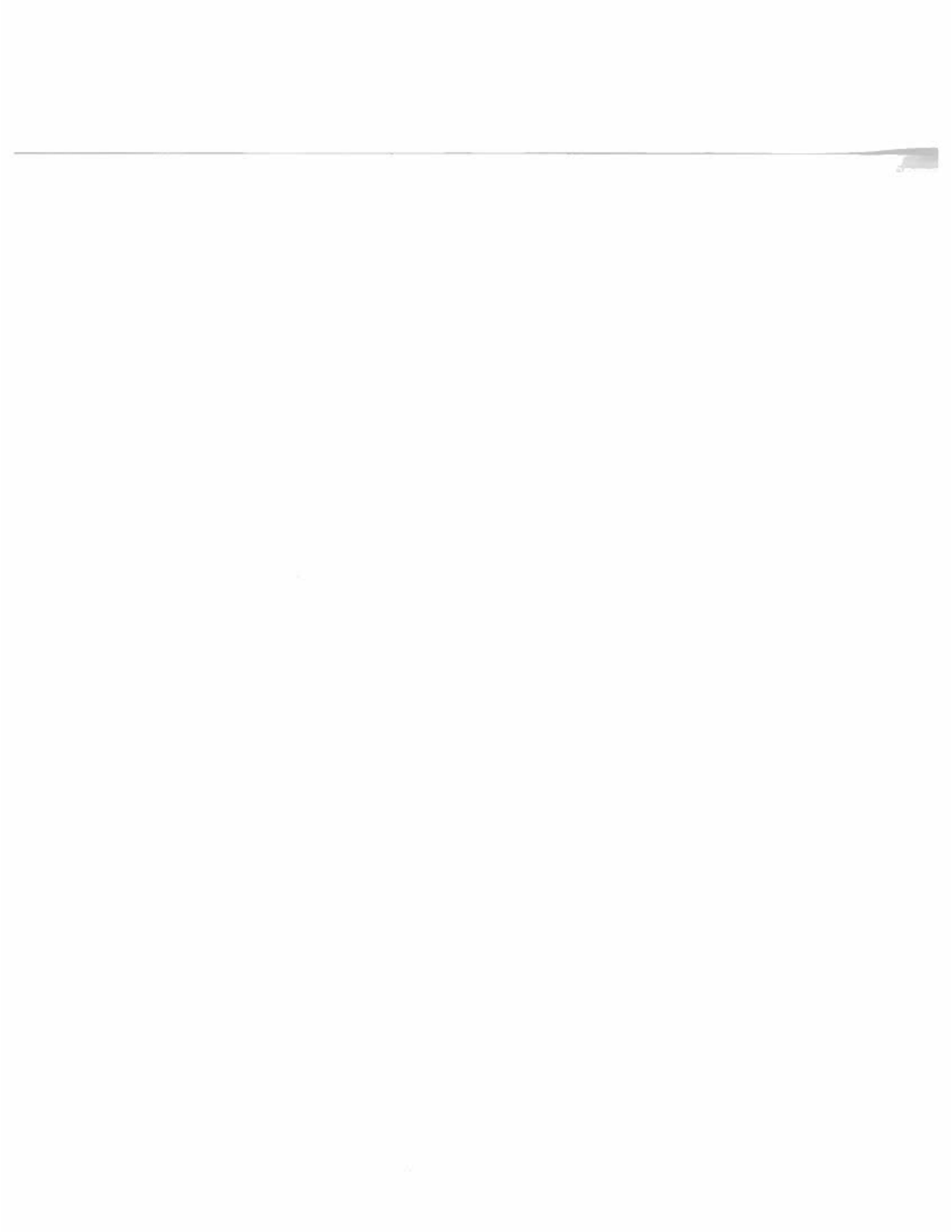

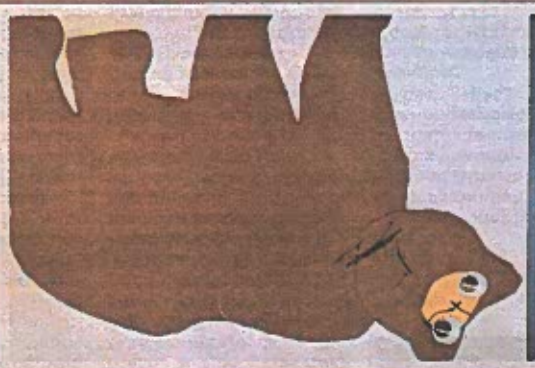
